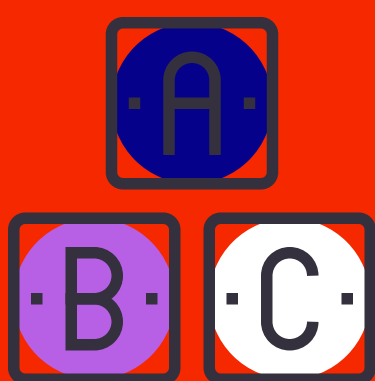


5 Ways To Engage With Savannah Votes

HERE ARE 5 WAYS VOLUNTEERS CAN ENGAGE WITH OUR VOTER REGISTRATION CAMPAIGN

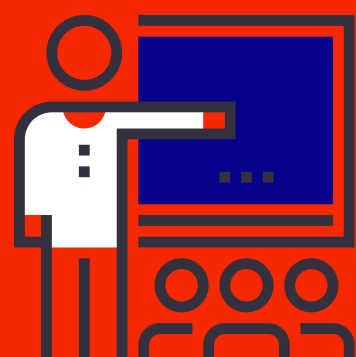


1.) VOLUNTEER AT AN UPCOMING EVENT.

Whether you're great at gathering data, event planning, organizing or would like to lead a training, take the initiative. We're here for it!

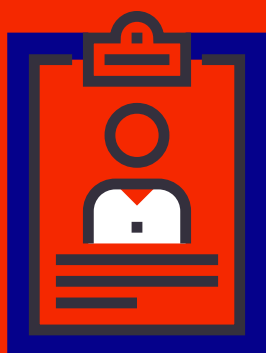
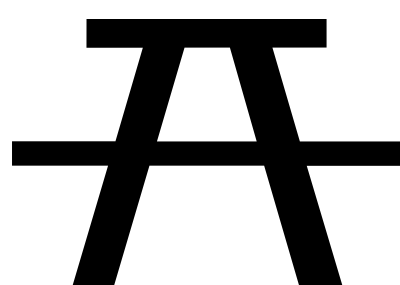


3.) SHARE OUR WORK WITH OTHERS.
